GUIDELINES

THEME

Within the theme of "Asian Approaches to Conservation", eligible graduate students are invited to create a poster that will convey the objectives, methods, and outcomes of a conservation project or research work.

The topic should be focused on conservation of tangible or intangible heritage, which would include but not be limited to any of the following: archaeology, architecture and urban conservation, mapping and revitalization of intangible heritage, museology, and heritage management.

Projects of all types, including both executed projects and academic exercises, are welcome.

POSTER

1-2 A1 sheets, horizontal or vertical format, produced in or after 2004. Both the hard copy and corresponding soft copy saved as a PDF file on a CD should be sent.

The poster should clearly include the name of the project. The name of the submitter should NOT be included on the poster.

LANGUAGE

English

NUMBER OF SUBMISSIONS

1 (one) per student or group

DESCRIPTION

All posters should be accompanied by a description of the conservation project/research work on a separate A4 sheet according to the attached template. In addition to the description, a full research paper/conservation plan can also be submitted if applicable.

NOTIFICATION

Eligible contestants will be notified by 15 September 2006 that their entries will be considered in the judging.

JUDGEMENT

Posters will be judged on the basis of (1) their relevance to the competition theme, (2) the appropriateness of the conservation proposal or research question, (3) the sophistication of the design or research methodology, (4) the presentation of the project, and (5) the creativity of the project.

DEADLINE

All entries should reach the AAHM Secretariat by 1 September 2006.

WINNER

Up to 3 winners (including 1 grand prize winner) will be announced at the AAHM Research Conference on 3 October 2006 in Bangkok, where the works will also be exhibited. The final number of winners remains at the discretion of the jury.

The grand prize winner will receive a partial sponsorship to participate in the next Field School conducted by the Asian Academy.

All winners will receive official AAHM certifications and conservation publications.

The results of the competition and the winning posters will be displayed on the AAHM website and will appear in publications by UNESCO and AAHM members.

All entrants agree that any image submitted to the contest may be used by the AAHM on behalf of UNESCO and ICCROM for publications, presentations, documents, and other promotional materials.
